**Lesson aims:** To highlight the importance of partnerships in The Foundation's programs to end avoidable blindness. Working with local partners ensures that local people have ownership of the program and builds local skills and resources to sustain the program for the long term.

<b>Lesson 1</b>	Profile of The Foundation's partnership with Tilganga Eye Centre in Nepal and comprehension questions	English/ HSIE	Copies of profile and questions for each student
<b>Lesson 2</b>	Students illustrate important events from the history of the Tilganga Eye Centre in Nepal	English/ Art	Copies of worksheet and copies of the profile from lesson 1
<b>Lesson 3</b>	Students work in pairs to read the story of a young woman in Nepal. They then role play an interviewer and the young woman	English/ HSIE	Copies of story and role play instructions
<b>Lesson 4</b>	Students piece together the story of a child who needs a cornea implant in Pakistan	English	Copy of worksheet and A4 paper for each student, glue and scissors
<b>Lesson 5</b>	Read the full version of the child's story, which highlights the way a partnership can work. Explain how different people were important in restoring the child's sight.	English/ HSIE	Copies of the full story from Lesson 4 and question sheet for each student.
